

TEQUILA SUNRISE

long drink

prepared in:

Highball

served in:

highball glass

alcohol content:

13.33% vol

INGREDIENTS

4.5 cl (1 ½ oz) Tequila 9.0 cl (3 oz) Fresh lime juice 1.5 cl (1/2 oz) Grenadine syrup

METHOD

Pour tequila and orange juice directly Into highball with ice cubes.

Add a splash of Grenadine syrup to create chromatic effect (sunrise), do not stir.

Garnish with orange slice and cherry.

Behind the cocktail

Cocktail name: Tequila sunrise.

Creator: Gene Sulit.

Venue: the cocktail was prepared the first time in Phoenix in Ariziona for a guest of a hotel

Story: the first cocktail named Tequila Sunrise dates back to the late 1930s. Gene Sulit, an Arizona barman in a Phoenix Hotel, created it for a regular customer of the hotel who was returning from a trip where he was struck by the dawn on the desert; arrived at the bar, he asked for a refreshing drink based on tequila.

Alcoholic base: tequila.

Type of preparation: stirred and built.
